3. Blue Bee (Sheffield)	GINGER	4.3	Fiery ginger pale V
4. Beowulf (Brownhills)	BLACK & BLUEBERRY	4.5	A dark ale finished off with a judicious dose of blueberries. V
5. Beowulf	MERCIAN SHINE	5.0	A pale bitter ale with a fresh, hoppy and fruity aroma and a dry finish. V
6. Burning Sky (East Sussex)	AUTORA	5.6	Premium strength pale ale with blend of malts to provide a juicy backbone and a pale amber colour.
7. Burning Sky	WHAT GIVES	4.4	Extra pale malt with cara and a hint of pale crystal malts gives a classic snappy malt body to this beer.
8. Corinium (Cirencester)	CENTURION STOUT	4.7	Light bodied stout with toasty chocolate undertones.
9. Corinium	MOSAIC	4.5	An aromatic pale ale packed with floral fruity hoppy notes.
10. Cotswold Lion (Cheltenham)	IAN SCOTT TRIBUTE ALE *	5.0	Ruby coloured premium bitter, full of malt and fruit flavours.
11. Cotswold Lion	SHEPHERDS DELIGHT	3.6	Crisp light, golden ale with a refreshing clean citrus flavour.
12. Donnington (Stow on the Wold)	BB	3.6	A pleasant amber bitter with a slight hop aroma, a good balance of malt and hops in the mouth and a bitter aftertaste.
13. Donnington	COTSWOLD GOLD	4.0	Golden colour with a citrus flavour followed by a rounded malt finish.
14. Downlands (West Sussex)	EVENING STAR REVIVAL	4.8	A well-rounded, fruity APA with excellent bitterness in the finish. Smooth texture and full of malty flavour.
15. Fresh Standard (Nailsworth)	BYTER	3.0	Super bright, hoppy, relaxed pale ale. Not too bitter and brim full of flavour
16. Fresh Standard	SOFT	5.2	Hoppy pale ale juiced with aromatic new world hops. Tropical citrus flavours with a soft, low bitterness

17. Goffs (Winchcombe)	BLACK KNIGHT	5.3	A deep ruby red beer with powerful chocolate malt aromas and a hint of vanilla. A classic porter.
18. Goffs	JESTER BREW 31	4.7	A Cyro Mosaic Crush super soft hazy Pale Ale VF
19. Gorilla (Mexborough)	STOUTRAGEOUS	4.2	An Irish Stout with a rich mouthfeel, full of roast coffee and chocolate flavours – full bodied.
20. Hand (Worthing)	TEWNTY FOUR O4	5.2	Mountain IPA combines the resinous, piney bitterness of a West Coast IPA with the lighter, softer look and body and a bright stone fruit aroma of a NEIPA.
21. Hook Norton	HAYMAKER	5.0	Strong premium pale ale packed full of the quintessential British hop, Goldings, that delivers a smooth ale with a delicate and light fruit taste
22. Hook Norton	MILD	2.8	Dark chestnut and full of roasty toasty malt flavours dry-hop floral aromas of light spice.
23. Kings Cliffe (Peterborough)	5C	3.8	Golden with gentle hoppy taste and clean, refreshing finish session beer
24. Kings Cliffe	No.10	4.0	Traditional English hop varieties and crystal malt combine to create this amber coloured English ale.
25. Little Critters (Sheffield)	HEAD BANGER	4.4	Session IPA
26. Little Monsters (Chichester)	FAVOURITE FOR A LONG TIME	4.3	Hazy Pale with Vista and Necteron Hops. Unfined. VF
27. Little Monsters	BRU 3	6.5	New England IPA. VF
28. Little Monsters	BIG RED MACHINE	5.2	A red ale based on a Flemish Red Strong malt flavours and fruitiness of plum, orange and red currants
29. Ludlow	RED DAWN	4.5	A refreshingly modern, hop-forward red ale. VF/GF
30. Moor	GLOSSED OVER	4.4	West Coast Pale. Fresh tasting, balanced with just the right notes of malt and hops on the palate. VF
31. Nene Valley (Peterborough)	MAHATTEN PROJECT	4.0	A light Pale and refreshing beer with lots of citrus and tropical flavours. GF

32. Nene Valley	LOOP DADDY	3.8	Golden full of Cascade, Magnum, Mosaic and Azacca Cryo hops. GF
33. North Cotswold (Shipston)	JUMPING JACK FLASH	3.8	Crisp, hoppy refreshing pale ale.
34. North Cotswold	NAO FAZ MAL	5.6	Earthy fruity hoppy IPA
35. Shakespeare	TEMPEST	5.2	Refreshing vibrant golden ale
36. Shiny (Derbyshire)	REES STOUT	5.5	Devilishly rich peanut butter milk stout VF
37. Shiny	CHINOCK TYPE BEATS	4.1	Pale Single Hopped, full of grapefruit and piney notes. VF/GF
38. Stardust (Maidenhead)	PK3	5.6	IPA. Five hop varieties throughout the brew, the beer carries a complex hop profile. Tropical, fruity, spicy.

40. Steam Town	BARTON BITTER	4.0	A traditional English Bitter with Maris Otter Crystal and pale malt, plus British hops
41. Tiny Rebel (Newport)	BEACH OFF	4.3	Apricot & Vanilla Milkshake IPA Super smooth and packed pull of flavour, rich and creamy with delightful apricot notes
42. Tiny Rebel	CALIFORNIA LOVE	5.0	A vibrant West Coast IPA crafted with five malts and a perfect blend of Cascade, Citra, and Columbus hops.
43. Triple Point (Sheffield)	GOLD	4.0	A great sessionable golden ale perfect for summer.
44. Uley (Dursley)	TAVENAR	4.5	Best Bitter. This copper-coloured beer is smooth, long and very refreshing.
45. Xtreme (Peterborough)	RHUBARB AND CUSTARD	6.0	Porter with an Xtra good helping of Rhubarb and flavoured with Vanilla to make an interesting combination of sweet and tart.
46. Xtreme	CHINOOX	4.3	A light pale ale made with the single hop Chinook. Light citrus with subtle grapefruit and a slightly spicy pine finish.
