1. Ashton (Cheltenham)	KAKAPO	4.3	A refreshing session pale ale brewed with the unique Nelson Sauvignon hop from New Zealand.
2. Ashton	SHOT IN THE DARK	4.6	A traditional porter made with dark roast malt
3. Bewdley	WORCESTER WAY	3.6	Pale straw colour. A refreshing session beer with citrus after tones.
4. Bewdley	MUCKLOWS MILD	6.0	A dark, sweetish, strong Ale with smooth fruity flavour & slight Licorice after taste.
5. Bewdley	RED HILL	4.2	Traditional English Ale. A rich and moreish flavour with pine, sweet fruit, berry and smooth spice aroma.
6. Brew 61 (Bromsgrove)	BRAMLING BAST	4.0	Best bitter. A refreshing bitter with a delicate hint of tangerine in the background.
7. Brew 61	BDA (Bromsgrove Dark Ale)	4.0	A full bodied English dark ale, with a strong malt palate and a smooth chocolate finish.
8. Brew 61	HAZY BALE	5.0	A hoppy, juicy, hazy IPA with a tropical aroma.
9. Brew 61	GREENFIELDS GOLD	3.8	Light golden session IPA
10. Cotswold Lion (Cheltenham)	DROVERS RETURN	5.0	Ruby coloured premium bitter, full of malt and fruit flavours.
11. Cotswold Lion	SHEPHERDS DELIGHT	3.6	Crisp light, golden ale with a refreshing clean citrus flavour.
12. Donnington (Stow on the Wold)	BB	3.6	A pleasant amber bitter with a slight hop aroma, a good balance of malt and hops in the mouth and a bitter aftertaste.
13. Donnington	COTSWOLD GOLD	4.0	Golden colour with a citrus flavor followed by a rounded malt finish.
14. Goffs (Winchcombe)	BLACK NIGHT	5.3	A deep ruby red beer with chocolate malt aromas and a hit of vanilla
15. Goffs	CHELTENHAM GOLD	4.5	American hopped Golden Ale brewed with a blend of seven hops
16. Goffs	JESTER BREW 8	4.6	American Pale with tropical fruit aromas and hoppy bite. VF
17. Hobsons (Tenbury Wells)	TOWN CRIER	4.5	Crisp full-flavoured golden ale brewed with British hops.

18. Hobsons	CHAMPION MILD	3.2	A smooth character packed full of flavour and aromas of roast caramel, coffee and chocolate
19. Hobsons	TWISTED SPIRE	3.4	Light and refreshing with a full, up front hop flavour followed by a crisp bitterness and citrus aromas.
20. Hook Norton	FLAGSHIP	5.3	India Pale Ale with a fruity mouth feel and a distinctive sweet aroma and powerful hop punch.,
21. Hook Norton	OFF THE HOOK	4.3	A strong combination of citrus and orange notes delivering a full on refreshing beer.
22. Ledbury	BITTER	3.8	Traditional copper colour with a noticeably bitter start. Brewed with locally grown Admiral and Progress hops
23. Ledbury	DARK	3.9	Chocolate and coffee start with a smooth, mellow finish.
24. Ledbury	ROCK THE HOPS	4.8	Pale Ale brewed with a lot of international hops. Big complex flavours in a big pale ale.
25. Ledbury	IMPORTANCE OF USING ERNEST	4.0	English Pale Ale. Lemony flavours
26. Ledbury	HARLEQUIN & CENTENNIAL PALE	4.0	Pale Ale combination of the two hops produces citrus aroma finish.
27. Ludlow	BEST	3.7	Golden Amber Best Bitter
28. Ludlow	BLACK KNIGHT	4.5	Ruby smoky and nutty Stout
29. Ludlow	RED DAWN	4.5	A refreshingly modern, hop-forward red ale.
30. Ludlow	STAIRWAY	5.0	Golden Ale full bodied with citrus and floral notes.
31. North Cotswold (Shipston)	THE FREEDOM IPA	5.2	Golden Double IPA with Idaho7 hops. Tropical Fruits, Pine and Pink Grapefruits notes
32. North Cotswold	HUNG, DRAWN AND DOUBLE PORTER	6.1	A dark porter infused with Port.
33. RBA (Derby)	EQUINOX	4.7	British Golden Ale with delicate fruity taste.
34. RBA	MIDNIGHT ORANGE	5.8	American Porter full of chocolate and a splash of orange in the finish
35. Salopian (Shrewsbury)	HALF LIFE	3.7	English Pale Ale. Crisp, with lightly juicy citrusy hops; floral notes of lime and mango.

36. Salopian	FREEZE FRAME	4.8	Golden Ale. Fragrant grapefruit and lime-leaf-led aroma with a twist of bitterness
37. Salopian	ORACLE	4.0	A crisp, sparkling sunflower Gold ale with dry and refreshing long citrus aromatic finish.
38. Salopian	LEMOM DREAM	4.5	Golden ale brewed using organic lemons. Subtle zesty aromas and a citrus filled fruity finish.
39. Salopian	DARWINS ORIGIN	4.3	A copper-coloured Bitter with new and old-world hops gives distinctive lemony aroma and dry finish.
40. Shakespeare (Shipston)	FALSTAFFS FOLY	4.0	Session Bitter. Deep copper caramel and malty.
41. Stonehouse (Oswestry)	ADRIFT	4.5	Golden double dry hopped bitter. Low bitterness with big aroma and flavours of blackcurrant and orange
42. Stonehouse	EQUINOX	4.3	Pale Ale lightly hopped to give citrus and tropical fruit notes.
43. Tewkesbury	GOLD	4.1	Fresh tasting with citrus notes.
44. Tewkesbury	DARK KNIGHT	4.8	A subtle stout with hints of chocolate and coffee. Vegan.
45. Three Tuns (Bishops Castle)	XXX	4.3	A renowned beer with a 17th-century Three Tuns Brewery recipe, A premium pale ale.
46. Three Tuns	RANTIPOLE	3.6	Session Bitter with refreshing ultra-light with delicate floral fruitiness.
47. Three Tuns	CLERIC CURE	5.0	IPA with mild malty sweetness, with spiced and floral flavours,
48. Woodcote (Bromsgrove)	SUPREME PALE ALE	4.2	Pale Ale with a modern twist, initial sweetness followed by a light bitter finish.
49. Woodcote	SQUIRES GOLD	4.5	Strong English Bitter, Aromas of sweet grain, honey and dried fruits smooth and soft on the tongue.
50. Woodcote	CRUSADE	4.5	A straw-coloured ale which initially seems sweet but a complex dry hoppy taste follows.
