Bluntrock	Red Rye	5.4	Red Ale	Red Rye from shipping container start up originally brewing IPAs
Bristol Beer Factory	Milk Stout	4.6	Milk Stout	Chocolatey sweetness balancing coffee bitterness, creamy, full-bodied
Butcombe	Original	4.5	Bitter	Clean, refreshing since the 1970's. Not trying to be different but very reliable
Exmoor	Beast	6.6	Porter	Dark mahogany-brown. Rich toffee aromas, rich but not cloying.
Exeter	Ferryman	4.2	Bitter	Copper best bitter since 2003 (then called Topsham & Exminster Brewery)
Firebrand	West Coast	4.2	IPA	Amber and clear with enchanting Elderflower and Orange aromas
New Bristol Brewery	Joy of Sesh	4.2	IPA	GF V Light citrus aroma, pale malt, lemon & fruit flavours, bitter finish
Padstow	Windjammer	4.3	Bitter	Specialty malts give copper colour. Smooth nutty finish, spiced fruit aroma
Penzance	Potion No. 9	4.2	Gold	Deep golden, grassy hop aroma. Lingering lemon gentle bitter finish
Salcombe	Shingle Bay	4.2	Gold	Aroma of blackberry and spiced fruit. Very easy drinking, with a crisp bite
Sharps	Sea Fury	5.0	Special Bitter	Brewed since 1996 for local fishermen to enjoy after perilous stints at sea
St Austell	Proper Job	4.5	IPA	Vibrant citrus, grapefruit and pineapple flavours. Crisp, bitter finish
Tintagel	Harbour Special	4.8	Bitter	Dark amber hue, an initial malty flavour with a crisp aftertaste
Tintagel	Sir Lancelot	4.2	Pale Ale	Light pale, dry hopped with Citra hops, great aroma, refreshingly juicy finish
Verdant	Miniature Cymbals	3.4	Pale Ale	Golden amber. Grassy hop finish. Medium bodied, smooth mouthfeel
Wiper & True	Heading Home	3.7	Mild	Brewed for Mild May by this innovative Bristol brewery
Wiper & True	Long Shadows	4.2	Bitter	A best bitter for those that don't like their beer very hoppy
